Your boardroom can be a place of breakthrough, not just business. Invite the Holy Spirit to sit at the table with you, to give you insight, timing, and wisdom. Lead by listening, first to Him, then to others. Be slow to speak, quick to understand, eager to build others up. When Christ is reflected through you, even secular spaces become sacred.
