- 3. **Pray with purpose**: Pray together for people in need, missionaries, or the persecuted church. Expand their prayer life beyond their personal desires.
- 4. **Tell Kingdom stories**: Share biographies of missionaries, evangelists, and everyday believers who lived for God's mission.
- 5. **Live sent**: Let your home carry a mission-minded atmosphere where your children know they're part of something eternal.

Raising kingdom-minded kids doesn't happen by accident. It happens when we show them the joy of living for something far greater than themselves.
