Serving Each Other in Grace

The call to love our siblings is not just about affection but a call to serve. It is in serving one another that we mirror the heart of Christ. - Respect their value system, especially if you are living under their roof.

Service also means stepping back when needed, praying for them fervently, and trusting God to do the work we cannot. Sometimes your service will look like silence instead of sarcasm, kindness instead of correction.

Galatians 5:13 says, "Serve one another humbly in love." This isn't a suggestion, it's the spiritual oxygen that keeps relationships alive.

When you choose to serve your siblings, you shift the dynamic from performance to partnership. You stop asking, "What can I get from them?" and start asking, "What can I give?"

And what you'll find is this: your acts of service, big or small, will begin to unlock the spiritual treasures buried in both you and them. Grace multiplies. Love deepens. The Holy Spirit flows more freely.
