

PASSIONATE CRY (PRAYER POINTS) OF A WIFE WHO DESIRES REALIGNMENT AND TRANSFORMATION TO MAKE HER MARRIAGE WORK

Introduction:

Marriage is one of God's most beautiful and sacred institutions, designed to reflect His love, unity, and grace. Yet, it is no secret that many marriages face seasons of struggle and brokenness, often rooted in attitudes, past wounds, and unresolved issues. For a wife who recognizes the weight of her own shortcomings, the journey toward healing and restoration begins with a deep, honest self-audit and a willingness to confront and transform those attitudes that hinder peace and oneness.

These prayers are crafted with compassion and spiritual authority for every wife who desires to reset her heart, realign her mind, and receive divine deliverance from the chains of past hurts and attitude problems. It is a passionate cry for God's intervention because true transformation can only come through Him, the Healer of broken hearts and Restorer of all things.

God's Word assures us that no marriage is beyond His reach. Even when the fault seems to lie heavily on one side, His power to forgive, renew, and rebuild is unlimited. The Bible teaches us that humility, repentance, and a heart open to change unlock heaven's blessings. **When a wife embraces this process, she becomes a catalyst for peace, joy, and growth within her home.**

If you find yourself struggling, carrying the burden of past mistakes or a hardened heart, know that God sees you, loves you, and stands ready to heal. These prayers invites you to partner with Him daily, to seek His truth, to surrender your will, and to receive the strength and wisdom necessary to restore your marriage. It is more than just prayer points; it is a spiritual journey toward wholeness, transformation, and unshakable covenant love.

Remember: *"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me."* (Psalm 51:10) **This is your season to be renewed, restored, and rejoiced in, for you and your marriage.**

Step forward with faith, knowing that as you humble yourself, God's grace will abound, and healing will flow, because no problem is too great for Him, and no heart too far from His mercy.

Note that you can start these prayers with an individual fasting program as it is always so good to start prayers with a lot of lightness.

Please any type of fast viz: dry, fruit, intermitted and stick to it for as long as the Holy Spirit Lead.
