

14 Days of Divine Alignment: Prayers for My Own Husband and Home

Guidelines Before You Begin

- **Fasting Option:** 6 AM to 6 PM daily (water allowed); break with light meal and prayer
- **Sanctification:** Avoid sin, worldly distractions, ungodly relationships
- **Spiritual Focus:** Worship, the Word, and listening to the Holy Spirit daily
- **Scripture Tools:** Psalms, Proverbs, Song of Solomon, Isaiah 62, and 1 Corinthians 7
- **Midnight Prayer:** Try to wake up at 12 midnight to pray at least 4 times during the period.

DAY 1 – ALIGNING WITH GOD’S WILL

Scriptures: Psalm 37:4, Jeremiah 29:11, Romans 12:2

Fasting Focus: Surrender your own will and timing to God

Sanctification: Purge fear, anxiety, and self-imposed timelines

Sanctification: Release bitterness, unforgiveness, and regrets
